

Breda City Council Minutes
April 11, 2022 City Hall

Mayor Dan Snyder called the meeting of the Breda City council to order with Bob Boeckman, Samantha Pietig, Kayla Tiefenthaler, Justin Agan and Chris Uhlenkamp present at City Hall. Motion by Pietig, seconded by Uhlenkamp to approve the agenda. Motion carried. Motion by Agan, seconded by Tiefenthaler to approve the consent agenda which included the minutes of the March 14th, 2022 meeting, claims, payroll, financial reports, and Red's Place liquor license. Motion Carried.

Fire Department report was given by City Clerk Rhonda Martin. Fire Department sold the older pumper truck and will be applying those funds to the principal of the existing loan for the new truck.

Dean Bruning and Bruce Boes were present to go over the events that will be happening the fourth of July weekend.

Public works report was heard. Discussed possibly getting a backup lift station pump due to supply chain issues. Council decided to revisit the issue in the fall. Public Works stated that the storm drain needs to be repaired at Maple and Third Street and that a utility pole will need to be replaced at that intersection in the future.

Council discussed the upcoming pool season and hiring lifeguards. Council considered wages for the pool season and concluded to keep all wages the same as the previous year. Decision was made on purchasing new pool chairs and benches. Opening day will be May 28, 2022

Council discussed current solar ordinance and decided to revisit after acquiring more information from the electric wholesale company and Region XII. Council considered getting security cameras at some of the City properties with ICAP Grant.

Council considered wages for the public works department and city clerk for FY2023. It was suggested that \$1 per hour increase. Motion by Boeckman, seconded by Pietig. Motion carried. Council considered the resolution 2022-04-01 approving wages for pool employees, public works, and city clerk. Voting: Tiefenthaler, Boeckman, Pietig, Uhlenkamp and Agan. All approved. Update given on fitness center equipment. City Clerk approved for training conference April 21 and 22, 2022. City Clean Up Days will be June 1-2.
